

Affordable


- Eliminates time and cost of travel

Amount of Content Per Slide

20-40 seconds per slide

Use animations

Limit text

Include pictures or illustrations

Pose questions

Are you a ready to be a Land Provider?

- ✓ Do you have land to lease or sell?
- ✓ What is your long-term vision for your land?
- ✓ What are the current uses of the land you have?
- ✓ How much land are you willing to lease or sell?
- ✓ Do you have specific enterprises you are willing to allow?
- ✓ What kind of arrangement are you willing to consider? (Lease, sell, crop share, alternative payment, partnership)
- ✓ Is water readily accessible?
- ✓ Are there other infrastructure pieces available? (Barn, shed, fencing, tractor, hoop house/greenhouse, milking equipment)
- ✓ Is there on-site housing available?
- ✓ Are you willing to mentor or advise?







Audio Equipment

- Use a cabled headset – preferably USB
- Make sure your co-presenters / guests have headsets

- Consider using a land line (not cell) telephone
- Know how to mute yourself, your co-presenters and your audience

Computer Equipment

- Install all your updates
- Turn off your screen saver
- Only open necessary program(s)

- Plug into power
- Turn off your computer notifications

- Practice handing off the mic and control of the slides






Practice!!
